**Flexible Intake:** Start at any time

**Prerequisites:** There are no formal entry requirements

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Basic *English, Literacy, Numeracy and computer skills* are required to undertake computer/online work. Students will also require *access to a computer and internet*. A Police Clearance will be required prior to commencing vocational placement (after completion of units) and must be dated within six months of the placement start date. In some cases, a Vaccination Certificate may also be required. Please note that manual handling tasks will be involved.
