To enrol, you must hold the CHC30121 or CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care or Australian Diploma/Certificate III in Children's Services. ## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- CHC30113/CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care **OR**
- An Australian Diploma/Certificate III in Children's Services. With at least 12 months of cumulative employment (full-time equivalent) within the last 5 years in a regulated education and care service in Australia, supported by verifiable evidence. **OR**
- Hold the CHCSS00147 Entry into Diploma of *Early Childhood Education and Care*.
