The **CHC43121 Certificate IV in Disability Support** is designed for individuals currently working in the disability sector who are ready to progress in their careers. This qualification reflects the role of workers who provide support in community settings and people's homes, empowering individuals with disabilities to achieve greater independence, self-reliance, community participation and wellbeing. You'll learn how to coordinate person-centred services, promote independence, facilitate social inclusion and skill development, and provide specialised care for people with complex needs—all while working confidently and without direct supervision.

With the community services and health industries growing rapidly, the demand for compassionate, qualified disability support workers continues to rise. This course offers strong job prospects for those looking to advance their role and provide a higher level of care. Workers may also be required to supervise or coordinate a small team. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Basic *English, Literacy, Numeracy and computer skills* are required to undertake computer/online work. Students will also require *access to a computer and internet*. Please note that job roles in the community and health industries sector may require manual handling tasks and vaccination evidence.

FUNDING ELIGIBILITY

Students are required to have **completed** *CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support* (or superseded qualification) AND be an **Existing Worker** in the *Disability industry*, which includes parents and unpaid carers of NDIS participants. (Evidence required e.g. payslips with job title and description.)
